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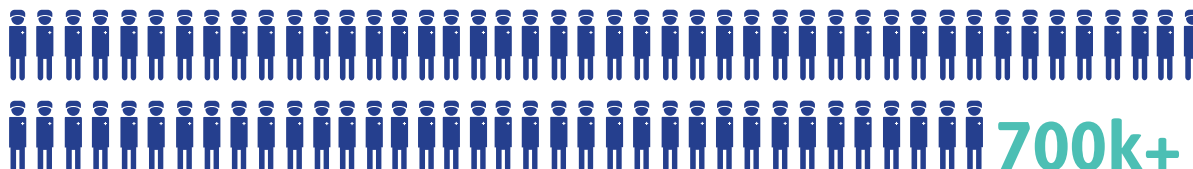
Revalidation has been introduced by the

Every **3 years** Nurses and Midwives will have to revalidate.



## Registered nurses & midwives in the UK



450 - 900 practice hours



35 hours CPD including 20 hours participatory learning



5 pieces of practice related feedback



5 written reflective accounts



Reflective discussions with another NMC registrant



Health and character declaration



Professional indemnity arrangements



Confirmation by a suitable individual
